

Checklist for Preparing Your Manufacturing Business for ERP Success

	efine Your Goals and Pain Points
	Identify the specific challenges your business faces today (e.g., data duplication, slow reporting).
	Set measurable goals for what success looks like after ERP implementation.
	Keep these goals documented and visible for your project team.
	lap Your Core Workflows
	Document how orders, purchasing, and production flow through your business.
	Note every handoff between departments and identify manual steps or delays.
	Highlight where real-time visibility would make the biggest impact.
	lean and Standardize Your Data
	Eliminate duplicate part numbers, vendors, and customer records. Standardize naming conventions and remove inactive SKUs. Assign one owner for each data category to maintain consistency.
□ E ₁	valuate System Connectivity
	List all systems currently used (accounting, inventory, CRM, EDI, shipping).
	Mark which ones exchange data automatically and which rely on manual entry.
	Identify integration opportunities for faster data flow.

□ Involve Your Team Early
 Engage key employees from every department before implementation.
☐ Collect input on pain points and wish-list improvements.
$\hfill \square$ Ensure everyone understands how ERP will support their daily work.
□ Prioritize — Don't Overload
 Focus first on the processes that will drive the biggest efficiency gains.
 Plan a phased rollout instead of doing everything at once.
☐ Add additional modules only after core functions are stable.
☐ Set Realistic Timelines and Resources
 Allocate time for data cleanup, training, and testing before go-live. Assign a dedicated internal project lead for accountability.
$\ \square$ Set milestones that your team can achieve without burning out.
☐ Train, Test, and Reinforce
$\ \square$ Begin training early and repeat sessions post-launch.
 Use real data scenarios during testing, not just samples.
☐ Create simple documentation for ongoing reference.
☐ Plan for Post-Go-Live Improvement
☐ Review progress 30, 60, and 90 days after go-live.
☐ Collect feedback from users and refine workflows.
Continuously identify new automation opportunities.
